COACHES: Please fill out the Waiver of Liability and the Consent to Treat. Return to me by mail. If a coach has registered through a MN youth association, I will need the PR code listed on the Individual Membership Registration (IMR). If the coach has registered online with USA Hockey ONLINE Registration, I will need the Online Confirmation Number.

PLAYERS (US CITIZENS) NEW TO THE WHITECAPS THIS SEASON: Please go to USA Hockey (www.usahockey.com) and register online. Please use your legal name. Send to me by USPS: Online Confirmation Number, Consent to Treat, Code of Conduct, a government issued document stating date of birth (birth certificate or passport copies).

PLAYERS (CANADIAN CITIZENS) NEW TO THE WHITECAPS THIS SEASON: Please go to USA Hockey (www.usahockey.com) and register online. Please use your legal name. Send to me by post: Online Confirmation Number, Consent to Treat, Code of Conduct, a government issued document stating date of birth (birth certificate or passport copies), and a copy of the US/Canadian Transfer form. If you believe that you have an unlimited transfer from years past, please check with me. I have a list of those that have been granted.

PLAYERS (US CITIZENS) HAVING PRIOR EXPERIENCE WITH WHITECAPS: Go to USA Hockey (www.usahockey.com) and register online. Please use your legal name. Send to me by USPS: Online Confirmation Number, Consent to Treat, and Code of Conduct.

PLAYERS (CANADIAN CITIZENS) HAVING PRIOR EXPERIENCE WITH WHITECAPS: Go to USA Hockey (www.usahockey.com) and register online. Please use your legal name. Send to me by USPS: Online Confirmation Number, Consent to Treat, and Code of Conduct. Several players have been granted unlimited waivers, so please contact me, prior to completing the US/Canadian Transfer.

PLAYERS (Non US/CANADIAN) NEW TO THE WHITECAPS THIS SEASON: Please go to USA Hockey (www.usahockey.com) and register online. Please use your legal name. Send to me by post: Online Confirmation Number, Consent to Treat, Code of Conduct, a government issued document stating date of birth (birth certificate or passport copies) A transfer from the IIHF is needed in this situation, and Kristie and I will work with you individually.
